

Corrigendum Regarding Ph.D. Ordinance

In continuation of the Ph. D. ordinance, there is a certain modification in clause no. 5.1, 8.1, and 14.3.

5.1. The minimum duration for submission of Ph.D. thesis for a candidate enrolled in the Full-Time Ph.D. Program of the university shall be of 03 years from the date of registration and for the Part-Time Ph.D. Program of the university shall be of 4 years from the date of registration.

14.3 All the Ph.D. candidates (both full-time and part-time) shall be permitted to submit their thesis provided they had published at least two research papers (relevant to their area of research) in the UGC CARE / SCI / Scopus Journals besides fulfilling all other requirements. The Doctoral Committee should certify the above fact including the quality of research publications. The candidate should be the first author including the name of the concerned Supervisor and Co-Supervisor. Ph.D. candidates can publish the paper in the same journal but the issues of the published paper should be different, and Ph.D. candidates must ensure before publication that Patrika indexed in the UGC CARE list would not be accepted.

For NET Exemption, Ph.D. candidates (both full-time and part-time) should follow UGC guidelines.
